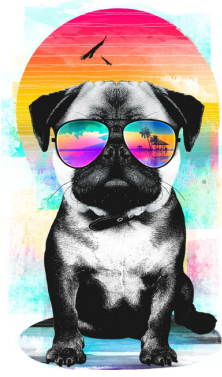
1,000 Books!
